- designed to assist veterinary services and to inform stakeholders of animal welfare organisations dedicated to rescue animals from other countries



Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005

Problems in general:

- ➤ indistinct legal terminology (see Rabitsch & Franzky, p. 41 TVT- News 2/2014)
- missing specific requirements concerning companion animals
- inconsistent implementation of Art. 7 and Art. 11 of Reg. No. 1/2005



reporting violations

controls of "illegal" companion animal transports:

 infringements of animal welfare and animals disease control regulations

reports to contact points

reporting schemes



Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005

Recommendations:

> study to compare legal inforcement of Council Regulation (EC) No. 1/2005

➤ harmonized sanctions for violations of existing EU-legislation on animal transport (Art. 25)

revision of Reg. (EC) No. 1/2005

verification of dual criminality under the principle of mutual recognition of court decisions

COUNCIL FRAMEWORK DECISION 2005/214/JHA


Article 5: 39 offences, some might be observed with illegal trade of companion animals (swindling, forgery of documents, smuggling of goods).



Violations against animal welfare or disease control legislation are not included in the scope of Art. 5 offences...

but could be!





enhance and accelerate procedures and successful prosecution!




Recommendations

- ✓ compulsory ID and registration, passports linked with transponders, distribution limited to the country of origin
- ✓ compulsory licensing of breeders and rehoming organizations
- ✓ Ban on sale of dogs and cats in pet shops, at markets, at shows and exhibitions, in the street and in public places



Recommendations

✓ control of internet trade



✓ Specific requirements for the transport

of cats and dogs





Recommendations

Most of all we want to emphasize the demand for:

✓ consistent and harmonized implementation and enforcement of prosecution of violators of animal welfare and animal health legislation (breeders, dealers, vets in all positions, transporters and procuring organizations)
